# STELIA Aerospace LAYS THE FOUNDATION STONE OF ITS NEW TOULOUSE OFFICES IN COLOMIERS

With the start of the construction of its future new offices in Colomiers, Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June is an important date in the development of STELIA Aerospace. This new building, with its aesthetic design, will welcome all the Toulouse employees and the Group's top management at the beginning of 2018.

In the presence of Mrs. Karine TRAVAL MICHELET, Mayor of Colomiers – Vice-President of Toulouse Métropole, and Mr. Bernard KELLER, Toulouse Métropole, in charge of Aeronautics, Space and Airport platforms, Mr. Cédric GAUTIER, CEO of STELIA Aerospace, has symbolically laid the foundation stone of the company's future offices.

Located in Colomiers, close to the « Arc en ciel » ringroad and halfway between the Ramassiers and Saint-Martin du Touch train stations, this new building will host all of the STELIA Aerospace teams and top management. Laid out on 6 floors and over 15,000 sq. meters of offices, the 350 engineers from the Design Office, the 200 employees of support functions (human resources, finance, strategy, procurement, marketing, quality...) and the 300 engineers of STELIA Aerospace's partner companies will benefit from a unique working environment, with 650 parking spaces and a 1,100 sq. meter company restaurant.

"This new building is a remarkable project!" said Mr. Cédric GAUTIER after laying the foundation stone. "This beautiful building will create working conditions adapted to collaborative work, essential for supporting the transformation and development of STELIA Aerospace" he added, before outlining: "This project will enable our company to benefit from a nice visibility in the Toulouse aeronautical area in 2018".

"Colomiers is delighted to welcome STELIA Aerospace in the heart of the Ramassiers industrial zone, just minutes from the Aeronautical park", said Mrs. Karine TRAVAL-MICHELET, Mayor of Colomiers and Vice-President of Toulouse Métropole. "Our city confirms once again its aeronautic and economic vocation within
